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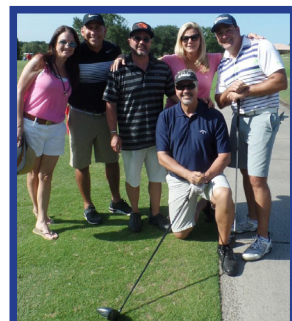
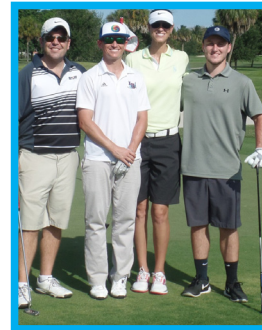
event management to Fortune 500 companies and non-profit organizations.

Baptist South Miami Hospital Pavilion – Multimillion dollar renovation included over 50,000 SF of updates completed in multiple phases, as well as select updates to the pavilion's first and second floors. Anthem Simply Health 85,000 SF Office Build-out – 85,000 SF high-end office build-out was finished in a record two and a half months and is one of the largest single floor office spaces in South Florida. Florida Citrus Bowl – This \$207 million dollar project was completed in a record ten months requiring around the clock work by over

1,200 workers daily. The project included demolition of 90% of the original 80-year old stadium and provided an increase in capacity to more than 65,000 seats. In addition to the increased capacity, thirty-three luxury suites were added along with a 10,000 SF party deck and new jumbo video screens.

Recently, Titus was selected as the winner of the 2017 CISCA Excellence in Construction Award for its Faena Forum Dome project located in Miami Beach, FL. This award from the Ceilings and Interior Systems Construction Association (CISCA) recognizes highly complex ceiling projects with unique design and aesthetic characteristics. The award was presented at this year's awards ceremony held at the Mandalay Bay in Las Vegas and was accepted by Titus owners Bill Hassel and Nathan Pardue. The firm accomplishment was also featured in Acoustical Interior Construction Magazine.

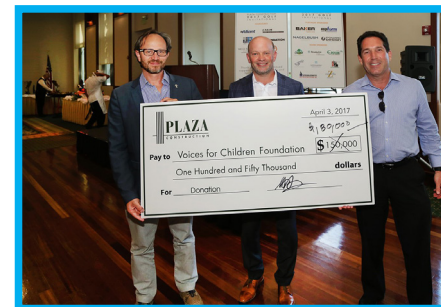

Miller Construction Company Completes 602,657 SF Centergate at Gratigny

Delivering Miami-Dade County's largest new industrial project on a fast-track schedule, Miller Construction Company has completed the 602,657-square-foot second phase of Centergate at Gratigny business park in Hialeah. The massive project demanded quick, creative

solutions -- from accessing utilities, to pouring 28,000 yards of concrete in just three months. Miller drew on its experience building more than 5 million square feet of industrial space to deliver the \$25 million project on schedule and on budget, despite extreme timing challenges, according to Miller Senior Vice President Brian Sudduth.

A significant challenge for the design and construction team was getting utilities to the +30 acre site. Taking an unconventional approach after careful cost analysis, they succeeded in saving the owner time and money by building a private lift station instead of tying into the existing sewer lines. The team also worked closely with the Public Works Department to quickly solve flow issues from the City's water main serving the site.

Designed by RLC Architects of Boca Raton, the twin, 301,000-square-foot structures in Centergate at Gratigny's new phase provide 32-foot clear height and 54-foot column spacing for efficient racking, and a 185-foot truck court plus 60-foot speed bay. Fairchild Partners is handling leasing of the development, which includes corporate-caliber office space, security-controlled access for all bays and fully air-conditioned mezzanine.

Launched to meet eastern Miami-Dade County's demand for upscale, next-generation industrial space, Centergate at Gratigny's latest phase is adjacent to the CSX rail line and strategically positioned at the southeast intersection of the Gratigny Parkway and LeJeune Road, offering direct access to business, commercial and residential destinations.
