

Southeast Mechanical and C. Davis Electric shoot to a draw

A record 58 teams participated in the 11th annual CASF Sporting Clays Team Challenge, held at the South Florida Shooting Club on Friday, March 12. For the first time, two teams tied for top honors with identical scores of 369 points. The Southeast Mechanical team of Brian Mueller, Dave Chiardonna, Todd Macklin and Anthony Sturgess split first place with the C. Davis Electric team of Bryan Schultz, Eric Fabritius, Doug Martin and Mike Gagliano.

"The field has grown considerably in the past few years, and that's made the tournament more competitive," said CASF Executive Director Remy Mackowski. "The top five teams were separated by just four points."

Finishing just behind the Southeast and C. Davis teams, with a score of 367, was the third place Titan Florida team of Joe Rivero, Oleg Pyrig, Ray Casais and Brett Merfeld. The top Individual Shooter Award went to Chris Berardinelli for the third year in a row. He shot a near-perfect 99 and helped propel the Universal Engineering Sciences team to a fourth-place finish with 366 total points.

"The conditions were ideal, and even though the field was completely sold-out, there were no hold-ups on the course," said Mackowski. "Just a perfect day. This Clays Challenge has grown over the years to become one of CASF's signature annual events."

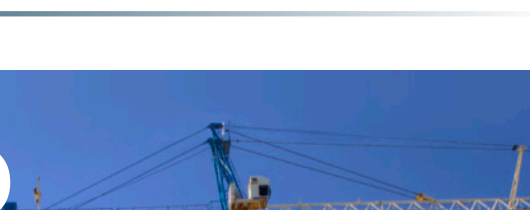

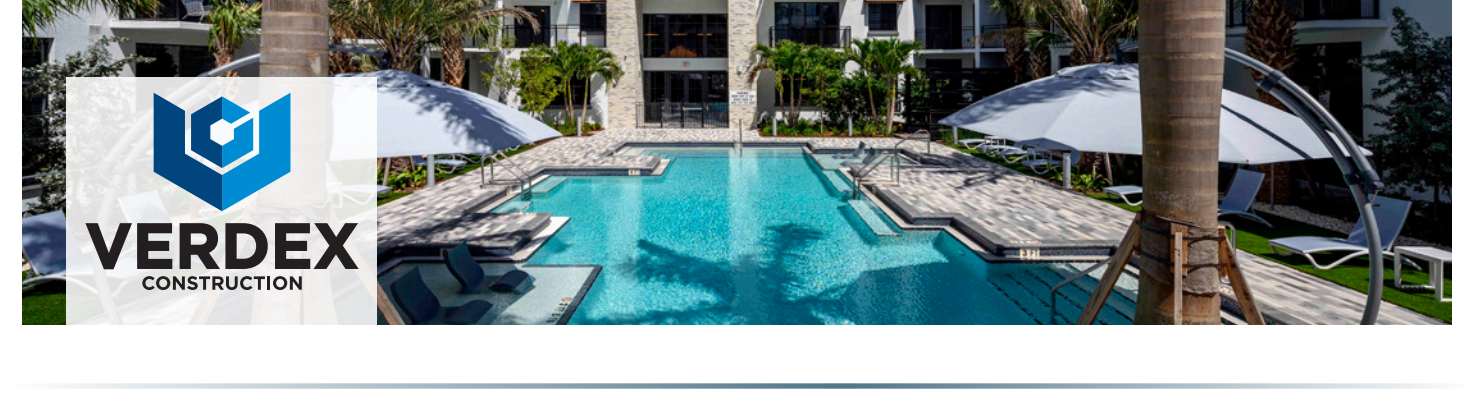

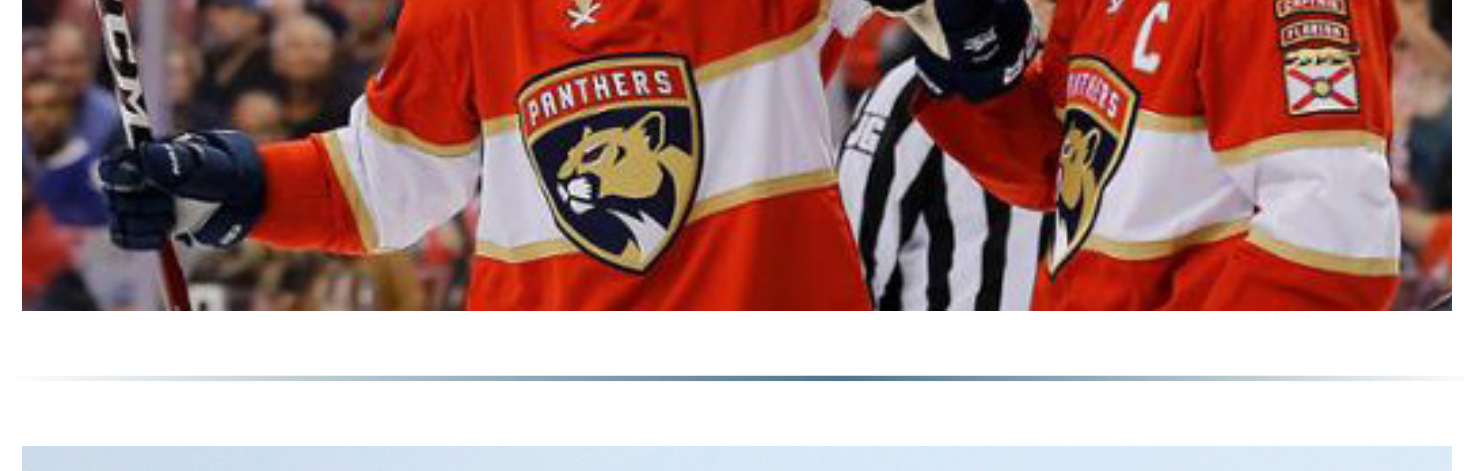
